Program Outcome 1 Completion Rates:

The majority (75-100%) of the RN-BSN students will complete the degree requirements within 5 semesters beginning with entrance into 1st nursing course.

The majority (75-100%) of Part-time RN-BSN Students will complete the degree requirements within 7 semesters beginning with 1st nursing course.

The majority (75-100%) of Concurrently Enrolled (ASN/BSN) students will complete the degree requirements within 8 semesters beginning with their 1st nursing course.
